## Camp Rules Acknowledgement Form

- Required Paperwork: All guests are required to provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance or to complete our General Release of Liability and to provide a signed copy of the Campground Rules Acknowledgement
- Check in and Checkout: Check in is between 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Check out is at 12:00 noon. If you plan to arrive earlier, we will do our best to accommodate your needs but cannot guarantee your site will be available. No arrivals after 10:00 PM without prior arrangements.
- Generators are not permitted at Camp Nauvoo
- Camping Sites: Please camp in the site reserved for you. Facilities are for registered campers only, sorry no day use or guests without prior permission
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children at all times and ensure they clean up after them especially in the lodge.
- Noise: Quiet hours are between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM. Hours are strictly enforced so all campers may enjoy their stay. You may listen to music but please keep it at a volume that does not disturb neighboring campers.
- Please leave your campsite clean.
- Dogs: Friendly dogs are welcome at Camp Nauvoo for a fee at tent camping sites (see pet guidelines) and county leash rules are enforced. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed to roam free
- Common areas: All persons are expected to maintain the Common area facilities in a clean, neat and orderly manner.
- Smoking: Smoking is not permitted due to high fire **area**.
- Campfires: We do not allow any wood or charcoal burning at the campground, except in the designed areas.
- Swimming – there is no lifeguard on duty. Swimming is at your own risk and proper swimming attire is required.
- Safety and Security are the sole responsibility of the camper guest. You must notify Camp Nauvoo immediately at 916 207-9441 and report any unsafe or security issues.
- No rock throwing above the gazebo where there is swimming and fishing
- No bikes, scooters or skateboards
- Display or use of firearms or weapons of any kind are prohibited.
- Litter/waste: It is the responsibility of each camper to properly dispose of their garbage in the designated covered trash containers. The container lid or cover must be kept closed at all times.
- No open flames including candles
